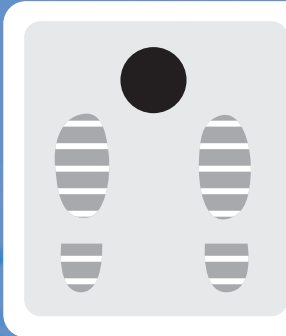




In **2010**

sanitation (3)



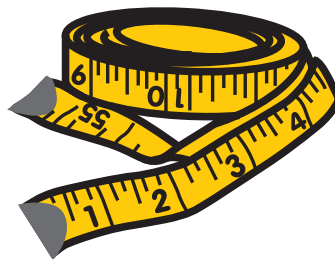
**884**

# The Human Right to Water



Between  
**50 and 100**  
liters of water per person  
per day are needed  
to ensure most basic  
needs (1)



The water source  
has to be within  
**1,000**  
meters from home (1)



Water cost should  
not exceed **3** per  
cent of household  
income (2)



Collection time  
should not exceed  
**30** minutes (1)
